





# **Text Analytics**

The myExperience evaluation software uses a custom dictionary and algorithms to examine the content of student comments. The dictionary contains key words and topics relevant to course evaluation feedback in higher education. Comments provided by students are placed into these topics and arranged into two categories – themes and elements. Text analytics is optimised when analysing a large number of comments – particularly when there are too many comments to analyse manually. ### **Themes**


This category is intended to identify themes related to the experience of the respondent. These could be positive, negative or neutral.




# **Elements**

Elements word cloud for "The best features of Gernot Heiser's teaching were?




Top five elements in response to "The best features of Gernot Heiser's teaching were?"
